RESOLUTIONS

Perhaps the most overhyped thing at this time of year is that of new year's resolutions. However, at North, part of our cycle of continuous improvement requires us to set goals to try to reach.

Here are just a few of our 2020 new year's resolutions...

- Implement flexible grouping time in Kindergarten, First, and Second Grades. This time will be literacy-focused, and it will allow teachers to work with groups of students specific to their current levels, needs, and abilities. This will happen once per week, but we anticipate that the time will be helpful in creating young readers! (Third-Fifth grade are already using data-driven flexible groups in both reading and math to meet student needs.)
- Expand our offerings for hands-on learning at North. We already have so much to offer, and we are writing grants to immerse our students in more opportunities to apply our curriculum in new and unique ways. Stay tuned for more!
- Continue to focus on kindness. While we aren't perfect, we are focused on ensuring that we are modeling and teaching kindness both during our TEAMology lessons and beyond.
